Main purpose of the Post:

The deputy headteacher, under the direction of the headteacher, will take a major role in:

- Deputising in the absence of the Headteacher, when necessary, to ensure the smooth running of school
- Being an integral part of a strong Senior Leadership Team
- Formulating the aims and objectives of the school
- Establishing policies for achieving these aims and objectives
- Monitoring progress towards the achievement of the school's aims and objectives
- Taking responsibility for developing the whole school curriculum
- The deputy headteacher will also be expected to fulfil the professional responsibilities of a headteacher, as set out in the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document (STPCD).

Qualities

The deputy headteacher will:

- Uphold staff and community trust in school leadership, and maintain high standards of ethics, behaviour and professional conduct
- Build positive and respectful relationships across the school community
- Serve in the best interests of our staff & pupils

Duties and responsibilities

School Culture and Behaviour

The deputy headteacher will:

- Work alongside the Senior Leadership Team (SLT) and other staff members to create a culture where pupils experience a positive and enriching school life
- Be an inspirational teacher who will make a positive impact on the outcomes of our children
- Be flexible, innovative, imaginative and creative
- Be strongly committed to social inclusion
- Have a positive approach to behaviour management with a proven record of success
- Bring a sense of energy, enthusiasm and humour to the role
- Uphold educational standards in order to prepare pupils from all backgrounds for their next phase of education and life
- Ensure a culture of staff professionalism

Teaching, Curriculum and Assessment

The deputy headteacher will:

- Establish and sustain high-quality teaching across all subjects and phases, based on evidence
- Effectively use formative assessment to inform strategy and decisions
- Ensure the teaching of a broad, structured and coherent curriculum
- Establish whole school curriculum leadership, including subject leaders with relevant expertise and access to professional networks and communities
- Use valid, reliable and proportionate approaches to assessing pupils' knowledge and understanding of the curriculum

Organisational Management and School Improvement

Under the direction of the headteacher, the deputy headteacher will:

- Establish and sustain the school's ethos and strategic direction together with the governing body and through consultation with the school community
- Establish and oversee systems, processes and policies so the school can operate effectively
- Ensure staff and pupils' safety and welfare through effective approaches to safeguarding
- Manage staff with due attention to workload
- Ensure rigorous approaches to identifying, managing and mitigating risk
- Identify problems and barriers to school effectiveness, and develop strategies for school improvement that are realistic, timely and suited to the school's context
- Make sure these school improvement strategies are effectively implemented

Professional Development

Under the direction of the headteacher, the deputy headteacher will:

- Ensure staff have access to appropriate, high standard professional development opportunities
- Keep up to date with developments in education
- Seek training and continuing professional development to meet needs

Governance, Accountability and Working in Partnership

Under the direction of the headteacher, the deputy headteacher will:

- Understand and welcome the role of effective governance, including accepting responsibility
- Ensure that staff understand their professional responsibilities and are held to account
- Ensure the school effectively and efficiently operates within the required regulatory frameworks and meets all statutory duties
- Work collaboratively with other schools and organisations
- Maintain working relationships with fellow professionals and colleagues to improve educational outcomes for all pupils
