#### Context of the post:

The successful candidate will contribute to creation of the next strategic plan. The Deputy and Assistant Headteachers will act as the link between the Leadership Team and specified academic department, meeting regularly and proving support, leadership and guidance to the relevant Subject Leaders on all curriculum, student and staffing matters, taking action to resolve issues of concern and reporting back to the Leadership Team on issues of relevance. A similar pattern of line management will exist in the line management of Heads of Year.
