

Job Description

Post title: Technician (Design & Technology)

Salary: Grade 3

Hours: 37 hours per week (term time only)

Accountable and responsible to: Head of Faculty

Purpose of the Post:

To support teaching staff in the following key areas of operation of the school:

- Technical, logistical and curriculum support within the academy
- Maintenance of a safe working environment
- Supervision of students as and when needed under the direction of the Head of Faculty

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- To assist teaching staff with classroom practical lessons by preparing equipment and materials.
 Demonstrating good practice and helping students when needed under the direction of the Head of Faculty.
- To operate an efficient system for stocking, storing, transporting and distributing assigned items used in the faculty.
- Keeping up to date records of stock.
- Ensure the availability of suitable materials and equipment, helping to compile orders and liaising or negotiating with suppliers and finance departments. The will include sourcing, costing and suggesting economic alternatives to maintain stock levels.
- To construct and / or modify simple teaching aids in all faculty areas as needed.
- To be responsible for the repair and maintenance of all machinery, hand tools, utensils and equipment within the faculty including safety equipment and to liaise with Facilities Management and external maintenance staff as necessary.
- To be responsible for the maintenance of all DT rooms and for advising the Head of Faculty of any improvements needed in order to be compliant with CLEAPPS.
- Clean and maintain the good order of all equipment and working areas in workshops, cookery rooms and storage areas in line with health and safety standards.
- To be responsible for keeping risk assessments up to date, for advising the Head of Faculty of any hazards identified / improvements needed and for administering the academy Health and Safety Policy.
- Actively contribute to assessment, monitoring and review of both health and safety procedures and information resources.
- Keeping up to date with current procedures and practices through continuing professional development.
- The provision of technical advice and support on health and safety issues to teaching and technical staff.
- The safe treatment and disposal of used materials including hazardous substances and responding to actual or potential hazards.
- The health and safe storage and accessibility of equipment and materials.

- Ensure that both routine and non-routine checking, cleaning, maintenance, calibration, testing and repairing of equipment are carried out to the required standard.
- Audit updates on an annual basis.
- To attend meetings, conferences and courses to gather and share information essential for the
 efficient operation of department support within the school and to participate fully in the school's
 in-service development programme including leading sessions as required to provide technical
 support in other areas of the school under the direction of the Head of Faculty for buildings and
 site including manufacturing high quality resources and artefacts as requested.
- Any other agreed duties appropriate to and commensurate with the post.

Additional:

- All staff have a responsibility for providing and safeguarding the welfare of children and young people they are responsible for or come into contact with.
- The contents and allocation of particular responsibilities/duties may be amended after consultation from time to time as part of a broader structural review.
- The post holder may be required to attend, from time to time, training courses, conferences, seminars or other meetings as required by his/her own training needs and the needs of the service.
