Teaching Duties

Have regard for the curriculum of the school, with a view to promoting the development of the knowledge and aptitudes of pupils:

- Plan and prepare outstanding lessons
- Demonstrate outstanding teaching
- Differentiate
- Mark learning
- · Assess, record and report on the development, progress and attainment of pupils

Other activities

- Promote the progress and well-being of pupils
- Provide guidance and advice to pupils on educational and social matters and, where appropriate, about sources of more expert advice on specific questions; formulate relevant records and reports
- Communicate and consult with parents and carers of pupils
- Participate in meetings arranged for any of the purposes described above.

Assessments and reports

• Provide or contribute to oral and written assessments, reports and references relating to individual pupils and groups of pupils.

Appraisal or review of performance

• Participate in arrangements made in accordance with the current regulations for the appraisal or review of your performance and that of other teachers.

Review, induction, further training and development

- Observe requirements of school induction;
- Review from time to time your methods of teaching and programmes of work;
- Participate in all staff CPD sessions;
- Participate in arrangements for your ECT and further training and professional development as a teacher including undertaking training and professional development which aims to meet needs identified in planning and review statements.
