Job Title: Early Years Educator

LEAP Federation based at Gayhurst Primary School

Reporting to: Head of Early Years teacher, Deputy headteacher and Headteacher

Grade: Scale 5 Point 12-15

Purpose of the Post:

- To complement the professional work of teachers by taking responsibility for agreed learning activities under an agreed system of supervision.
- Provide a safe, well ordered environment for the children, ensure resources are well managed and the space is tidy and safe
- Take responsibility for day to day routines and training children where needed.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

• Support for Children:

- Under direction of the teacher ensure the children have a broad and varied diet of learning and play both inside and outside
- Support children with SEN and EAL.
- Accompany children on outside activities.
- Encourage children's development and independence.
- Observe and record children's activities.
- o Maintain respectful and genuine interaction with children.
- Be supportive and welcoming to parents.
- Meet with parents to discuss their children

- o Work with the leader of the provision to co-ordinate use of facilities
- o Induct, train and mentor less experienced staff.

Key Work:

- Oversee the introduction and settling in process for children.
- o Plan, track, and evaluate children's progress.
- o Set individual targets and monitor progress.
- Liaise with outside agencies and other professionals.

• Whole-School Improvement:

- Make sure that children are ready for the next stage of their education
- o Help children to meet developmental goals

• Safeguarding:

- o Maintain high standards of hygiene.
- o Attend to sick or injured children and apply First Aid.

Personal Care:

- Assist with changing nappies, dressing, feeding, and toileting children.
- Help children to eat snacks and school food where relevant training them to use cutlery and to sit at the tables

• Mentoring/Advising:

- o Mentor work experience students and less experienced staff.
- Any other work commensurate with the role as requested by senior leaders

Qualifications:

NNEB Level 3 qualification or equivalent.

Experience:

- Working with nursery aged children
- Significant experience in childcare roles.

Knowledge:

- Understanding of early childhood development.
- Knowledge of relevant policies and safeguarding issues.

Skills:

- Good numeracy and literacy skills.
- Effective use of ICT.
- Ability to relate well to children and adults and be a team player
- Create displays and home corners and fun learning environments
- Commitment to safeguarding children.
