## Our Location and Facilities

Newhampton Federation was created in May 2016 when Newtown C.E. Primary School and Welshampton C.E. Primary School Federated. The schools are situated in the heart of the beautiful Meres and Mosses of Shropshire. The area is a patchwork of farmland, woodland, mosses and meres. Both schools are small, friendly, family, village schools with Christian values and provide a safe, welcoming, happy and secure environment.



Newtown School C.E. Primary School is set in the rural hamlet of Newtown near Wem, Shropshire. The school has 118 fulltime pupils aged 4-11 and 9 part time aged 3-4 taught in 5 classrooms. In 2001 a new build was completed, comprising of a rural nursery, classroom, ICT suite, main reception, staffroom, headteachers office and secretary's office. This newest build joins the previous buildings to form one complete site offering excellent accommodation for its pupils.







Facilities within the school grounds include a live willow dome, gazebo, allotment, covered stage and activity trail. In summer 2015 a Creative studio was completed to further enhance the learning environment and opportunities for the children.

The Nursery classroom has an indoor/outdoor area with shelter and all-weather surface.

Facilities within the school grounds include a large games field with newly built canopy with all-weather surfacing, adventure

trail, trye park, garden and pond. This is in addition to a well-equipped playground with football pitch
