Letter from the Chair of Governors





Thank you for your interest in the post of executive headteacher. I have been the chair of governors for Truro Nursery School and now the federation since 2020. Due to the retirement/moving on to pastures new of the current headteachers, we are looking for a committed, inspiring and personable executive headteacher who will build on the existing outstanding performance of the two schools in our federation.

Truro Nursery School and Camborne Nursery School are the only two maintained nursery schools in Cornwall. The schools have a long history of working together and are currently led by two part time headteachers. The newly appointed full time executive headteacher will work across both schools and further develop the joint working across the federation.

Both existing headteachers have been in the role for over 10 years and have strong and stable teams of staff who have strong early years pedagogy. Both schools have an outstanding Ofsted grade.

We educate and care for between 150 and 200 children across the two sites which are geographically approximately 15 miles apart. The two nursery schools have very different catchment areas.

Camborne has a rich heritage of mining and a strong sense of community and belonging. It is one of the highest areas of deprivation in Cornwall. Camborne Nursery School sits at the heart of the community and provides a range of family support.

Truro is the Duchy's city and houses the main hospital for Cornwall. Truro Nursery School has many working families and a greater number of children with English as an additional language that the average for Cornwall.

Both schools offer outstanding inclusive provision for children with complex, special and additional needs and offer places for children aged 2-5 years old.

Our ethos is one that values all children as individuals and we work closely and in partnership with parents and carers. We are part of a strong and supportive local authority (not part of a multi academy trust) and work closely with a number of other schools and partnerships.

Both schools within the federation are Froebelian and place great value on the principles underpinning the Froebelian approach. Relationships underpin all that we do, play is central to our ethos and is supported by creating or co-creating real life and authentic learning experiences and opportunities.

The role is full time from September 2026. There will be a structure in place to fully support the new executive headteacher.

We look forward to welcoming you and encourage you to visit. Online visits can be arranged for out of area applicants.
