#### **Main Purpose of Role**

To work under the direction of the class teacher and EYFS team to support high-quality teaching and learning in the Early Years Foundation Stage, helping children to make excellent progress and ensuring their safety, development and wellbeing.

### **Main Duties and Responsibilities**

- Support children's learning and development in line with the EYFS statutory framework
- Act as a **key person** to a group of children and liaise with their families
- Deliver planned interventions in communication, phonics, early maths, and personal development
- Observe and record children's progress to inform assessment and planning
- Assist with the preparation of engaging learning environments and resources
- Promote positive behaviour and help maintain a safe, inclusive setting
- Supervise and support children during indoor and outdoor learning
- Support pupils with additional needs under the guidance of the teacher/SENDCo



- Work collaboratively with staff across the EYFS team and wider school
- Attend staff meetings and participate in CPD and training as required
- Ensure safeguarding policies and procedures are followed at all times

#### **Essential Criteria**

- Relevant EYFS qualification (as defined by the EYFS statutory framework)
- Good knowledge and understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum
- Understanding of **continuous provision** and its role in early childhood education
- Experience of working or volunteering in an EYFS setting
- Ability to develop strong relationships with children and their families
- High expectations for children's behaviour, wellbeing and achievement
- Strengths in **English and maths** to support early literacy and numeracy
- Positive, resilient and enthusiastic attitude towards supporting children's learning
- Ability to work flexibly and as part of a team
- Commitment to safeguarding, equality, and inclusion



## **Desirable Criteria**

- Paediatric First Aid qualification
- Experience supporting children with SEND and/or EAL
- Familiarity with observational assessment
- Knowledge of EYFS inspection frameworks
- Experience using phonics programmes (e.g. Read Write Inc, Letters and Sounds)
