Prime purpose

Duties and Responsibilities

- To carry out the statutory tasks comprehensively as laid down in the current School Teachers' Pay and Conditions of Service Document in the light of the procedures and guidelines adopted by the Governing Board
- To meet the teachers' standards
- To contribute to the Catholic life of the school community, rooted in the Eucharistic community it serves.

Classroom Practice

- Ensure the highest possible quality learning environment in the classroom and outdoor area which reflects the Catholic nature of the school as laid out in the school's Mission statement.
- Ensure that all teaching and learning is conducted in an atmosphere of affirmation, encouragement, realistic challenge and sensitive reflection
- Affirm and encourage parents in their role as the first educators of their children and ensure effective communication with parents is maintained
- Access and record each pupil's progress systematically in line with current school procedures and use the results to inform planning
- Constructively feedback to children on their learning so as to induce a positive impact on their outcomes
- Periodically, positively evaluate your own pedagogy to consolidate strengths and improve effectiveness when appropriate
- To be responsible for the specific areas of the school in relation to health and safety issues and report any concerns to your line manager or/and the premises manager.

Personal and Professional Requirements

- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with professional colleagues, acknowledging the need for mutual support
- Participate as required in meetings with professional colleagues and parents in respect of the duties and responsibilities of your post
- Take responsibility for your own professional development and on-going formation
- Endeavour to retain a healthy balance in your professional and personal life

- To be flexible and open to change with a positive optimistic mind-set.
