Purpose of Post

 To carry out practical tasks for the welfare of the animals on the farm, including looking after the animals' health and nutritional needs.

General responsibilities:

- Work with pupils and staff on the farm.
- To work with a range of animals including reptiles, small animals, poultry, equine and hoof stock
- Observe all legislative requirements as they relate to the work place, especially HSAW, and COSHH
- To ensure that all equipment is organized, safe and accessible to pupils.
- Under the supervision of the Farm Manager order food and supplies for the animals
- Maintain animal health records
- To support volunteers
- Establish and maintain a positive regard towards both pupils and staff, promoting equality and diversity.
- Work as a member of a team, planning co-operatively, sharing information, ideas and expertise.
- Be available to work out of school hours.
