



# Food Technology Technician

The successful candidate will work within the Art and Design Department reporting to the Food Technology Teacher and the Curriculum Team Leader for Art and Design. They will provide support in testing and setting up for practical lessons in the classroom. They will prepare and clear away equipment, food and materials as required within the food technology lessons. Previous experience is not essential but would be considered a benefit. A good standard of computer skills, literacy and the ability to prioritise is essential for this post. Key tasks are:

- To support the Food Technology curriculum by providing a safe, efficient, effective technician service.
- To retrieve and clearing away materials and equipment after practical activities; disposal of waste materials, including hazardous waste in accordance with established guidelines.
- To Undertake general maintenance, cleaning and repair of equipment and conducting scheduled safety checks and maintenance of laboratory facilities.
- To maintain the food tech lab and prep rooms in a tidy and clean condition, including cleaning sinks and keeping work surfaces clear.
