Scope: To lead Forest School Provision

Duties: The Conditions of Employment for School Teachers

(Document on Pay and Conditions) specify the general professional duties of all teachers. In addition, certain particular duties are reasonably required to be exercised and completed in a satisfactory manner.

Responsible for:

• Supporting the vision, ethos and policies of the Federation and promoting high levels of achievement

- Supporting the creation and implementation of the school's development plan
- Organising, managing and delivering Forest School teaching and learning
- The development and monitoring of the Forest School curriculum provision
- The pastoral care of children, promoting independence and good behaviour, in accordance with Federation policies.

Teaching and Learning

- To plan, prepare and deliver a range of Forest School sessions.
- To promote learning in the outdoor environment and the ethos of Forest Schools and outdoor learning

- To create and maintain an engaging, fun, and supportive Forest School environment
- To record pupils' development and progress
- To regularly check and maintain tools and other equipment, ensuring that they are stored safely
- To ensure the health and safety of all participants, including writing and checking risk assessments for the site, tolls and activities used
- To be responsible at all times for high standards of care and education for all
- To ensure effective communication with leaders, teachers, support staff and parents
- To regularly check and maintain tools and equipment
- To adhere to all policies

These duties may be varied to meet the changing demands of the school at the reasonable direction of the Executive Headteacher. This job description does not form part of the contract of employment. It describes the way the post holder is expected to perform and complete the duties as set out above.
