JOB TITLE: Full-time KS2 Teacher

GRADE: Main scale

RESPONSIBLE TO: Headteacher

RESPONSIBLE FOR: Deployment of support staff allocated

JOB PURPOSE: promote effective learning, appropriate achievement and

educational, social and personal progress of all pupils for whom the teacher is designated as being responsible, consistent with the Vision Statement, Aims and Christian values of the school

and the unique needs of each individual.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Develop and maintain an up-to-date knowledge and understanding of the areas of teaching and pupil support for which post-holder is responsible

- 2. Plan work to meet the learning needs of all pupils in a consistent and effective way
- 3. Use appropriate teaching and classroom management strategies to motivate pupils and enable each to progress
- 4. Monitor the progress of pupils for whom the postholder is responsible to set expectations and give constructive feedback
- 5. Maintain appropriate records to demonstrate progress made by pupils
- 6. Participate fully in professional development activities to develop practice further, sharing the learning from these as appropriate
- 7. Make an active contribution to the policies and aspirations of the school
- 8. To provide a stable, stimulating and safe learning environment for the children in your care
- 9. Recognise the need to work as a member of a team, supporting and monitoring areas of the curriculum that you have responsibility for
- 10. To attend staff development activities as directed by the Headteacher in order to increase skills, enhance ability and gain knowledge
- 11. Provide an example of good practice through quality teaching and learning, stimulating displays and clear differentiated planning and delivery
- 12. To work and plan with teaching assistants who support in your classroom to ensure that they are used effectively and productively for the benefit of the children.

- 13. To share responsibility for developing the cross curricular links with local churches, local community and colleagues from other settings
- 14. To nurture and encourage the Christian values of the school
- 15. To work closely with parents and carer to ensure strong home-school links are developed and maintained
- 16. To be proactive in Health and Safety issues pertaining to the school, staff and the children in your care
- 17. Undertake a shared subject co-ordinator role across the local schools' curriculum project with responsibility for helping to develop the curriculum and resources
- 18. Support the Initial Teacher Training by mentoring students in your class
- 19. Be willing to work collaboratively across both Egton CE Primary School and Danby CE Primary School

To fulfil all of the requirements and duties set out in the current Pay and Conditions Documents relating to the conditions of employment of teachers

To fulfil all of the responsibilities and duties required by the School's policies on teaching and learning.

To achieve any performance criteria or targets arising from the School's Performance Management arrangements
