### **Core purpose**

- To support the teacher with their responsibility for the development and exceptional education of children in schools. Using routine supervision and care skills to support children.
- Special Educational Needs Assistant To support individual and small groups of children, with additional SEN needs, under the direction of the class teacher.

# **Key accountabilities**

- To assist in the delivery of educational work programmes by participating in day to day learning activities, supporting children so that they achieve to the best of their abilities.
- To support in planning and evaluating programmes and adapting teaching materials to suit the particular requirements of individual children or groups of children.
- To discuss with and report back to the teacher on the assessment of children's work.
- To contribute to the carrying out of child programmes, including literacy and numeracy, keyboard skills, life skills and to ensure that the programme is delivered professionally at all times.
- To participate in staff development activities and, where required to contribute to any multidisciplinary discussion of a child's needs/progress.
- To organise and maintain the learning environment
- To work as part of a team to ensure that the well-being, behaviour and personal development of children enhances their learning opportunities and like skills.
- To maintain confidentiality in and outside the workplace.
- To understand and assist in interpreting school policies
- To participate in staff development activities and, where required to contribute to any multidisciplinary discussion of a child's needs/progress

#### Other

- Any other duties commensurate with the role as directed by the Head of School
- To work as a midday supervisor covering lunch duties

#### Accountability

- All Teaching Assistants and SEN Assistants are accountable to the Inclusion Manager,
  Deputy Head Teacher and Head of School
- GLF Schools expects its employees to work flexibly with the framework of the duties and responsibilities above. This means that the post holder may be expected to carry out work that is not specified in the job profile but which is within the remit of the duties and responsibilities.
