History is offered at GCSE and A Level with pupils following the Edexcel specification at GCSE and the OCR specification at A Level.

The department prides itself on the range of enrichment activities that are on offer to the pupils. In Year 8 pupils will visit Speke Hall, in Year 9 they will visit the Imperial War Museum. At GCSE they will visit Whitechapel in London and at A Level there is a trip to Berlin.
