A level English literature is a very popular subject choice, with 160 students studying the subject in years 12 and 13. 80 students took the GCE English literature exam in 2024 achieving an average grade of A. Many of our A level students' progress to the top Russell Group Universities (including Oxbridge) to study English literature and related subjects such as Law. At GCSE, 38% of our students achieved grades 7-9 in English language and 45% in English literature in 2024.
