The Director of STEM provides strategic support and direction to both our science and maths departments. The Director of STEM is not responsible for the leadership and running of the maths and science departments – that is the responsibility of the Head of Maths and the science leadership team – but this supportive structure will allow the successful applicant to work with and learn from one of the most credible and reputable maths system leaders across the North West.

We want our Head of Maths to develop and improve practice by having an open door, by working alongside dedicated and committed colleagues and by sharing best practice across what is a large department. We want our Head of Maths to be a role model and example for staff across the school, someone who welcomes visits to their classroom, who can mentor and coach others, who can contribute to and lead whole-school CPD on best classroom practice.
