The Modern Foreign Languages Faculty at Hall Park Academy is a thriving faculty. We teach both French and German from Year 7 through to Year 13, so the successful candidate will have the opportunity to teach French up to A-Level.

At Hall Park all students are taught French in Year 7 and 8, with the top two sets also being taught German. Students select their GCSE options at the end of Year 9 and recruitment to the AQA GCSE French and German courses is strong.

We are proud to be part of the Redhill Academy Trust and benefit from working collaboratively with the other MFL departments within the Trust. Being part of the Trust also allows our team to engage in regular high-quality CPD.

The Modern Foreign Languages Faculty is committed to providing opportunities for students to visit foreign countries and to learn about the culture of French- and German-speaking countries. We run an annual residential trip for students in Year 8-10 alternating between visiting Normandy and The Rhine Valley. We also have links with Thurgau University and, as such, benefit from a Swiss trainee teacher working with us for a three-week placement each year. Closer to home, we also have links with the University of Nottingham and engage with their MFL Widening Participation Programme as much as possible.

Modern Foreign Languages has raised its profile considerably at Hall Park over the last few years with 75% of our students now studying GCSE French and German and we look forward to the successful candidate being part of our department's ongoing development. We are always looking for ways to continue to improve our teaching and learning in MFL and to deliver the best possible outcomes for our students.
