We are currently promoting "growth and leadership" within our small team of teachers and staff and are also planning improvement to our outdoor learning and play areas for the children.

Our school foundations for learning are in great condition: we have dedicated and experienced teachers with superb TA support, our Ofsted rating is 'Good', attendance is very good, and pupil behaviour is excellent. We have an active PTA, a budget which balances for the foreseeable future, and you will benefit from an experienced and supportive board of governors. 
