



2. The School

The school is located in a well-maintained building dating back to 1869 The building houses 2 spacious classrooms, a hall, a staff room, a library, and an office. The school can also use the local village hall and the local church.

















3. The Location

The school is situated in the beautiful village of Litton to the East of the town of Buxton. The school grounds include a hard surface play area, woodchipped adventure trail, school garden and grassed play area. There is also a large area of woodland, outdoor classroom and pond.



Litton village is in the heart of the Peak District but easily reached from surrounding towns and cities. The village has a strong and supportive community



4. The village and local community

At the heart of the village is the green with its' old stocks, surrounded by pretty cottages, the school, a village shop and the pub. The village developed from farming and lead mining and Litton Mill down in the nearby Millers Dale was an early cotton mill. The village comes to life for its' annual Well Dressings and Fete in late June early July, at other times it is popular with walkers taking in the delights of the surrounding dales.

Litton Church of England Primary School: where every individual is inspired to learn and achieve in a safe and caring environment.


