To apply, please complete the attached application form as fully as possible, apart from Section 5. In place of Section 5 type a separate letter of no more than **1000 words** addressing the criteria of the Person Specification. We are looking for someone who is:

- a hardworking and nurturing professional who is passionate about standards and has high expectations
- a team player who is child-focussed and ready to lead by example.
- a resilient leader who can build on the school's current strengths and improve learning further by delivering on its improvement priorities.
- able to lead effectively and develop the committed and skilled staff.
- and capable of working constructively in partnership with pupils, staff, parents, governors and the wider community to reach the school's objectives

Please also note the following when completing your **application form**:

- Any gaps in paid employment should be accounted for in the section of the application form which asks you to detail periods of unremunerated activity.
- It is essential that one of your referees should be your current or most recent employer. If this employment does not involve working with children, your second referee should be your most recent employer **in relation to your work with children**. For an existing Headteacher of a maintained school this should be your County Council or for an Academy this should be the Chair of Governors or Academy Trust.
- If you are invited for interview, you will need to produce confirmation (originals) of the qualifications which you have indicated you hold.
