


We are seeking a compassionate, dynamic and visionary leader who will build on the child centred, caring ethos of the school.

Bellefield is first and foremost a happy school environment. The well-being of the children is our most important consideration. Staff like working here and children enjoy attending. We celebrate the difference and diversity that exists within our school and believe that Bellefield offers a rich and fulfilling learning environment in which children thrive. We are proud to be part of EQUA Mead Learning Trust and highly value our continued connection to the Diocese. Our link with the local community is strong and our pastoral care provision ensures that children and families receive access to the care they require.

Therefore, we are looking for someone with a strong, inclusive vision for the development of the school. About our school

We are very proud of our school and all our children. We have caring, hard working and committed staff at Bellefield; dedicated to developing the knowledge, skills and understanding to enable every single child to enjoy learning, achieve success and become a contented and fulfilled young person.

Bellefield CofE Primary and Nursery School is a larger than average sized primary school with around 310 children on roll in 10 classes plus an LA maintained Nursery catering for 52 children (26 in the morning and 26 in the afternoon). New for September 2025, we now have a Resource Base for children with communication and interaction needs.


There are on average around 30 children in each mainstream class with currently 10 spaces in our Resource Base. We have approximately 22% of children with a special educational need or disability. We have approximately 25% of pupils who are eligible for pupil premium funding.

This links to ‘Growing together to be the best we can be’.






