Thank you for expressing an interest in the role of Headteacher at our wonderful school. I am both proud and honoured to be Chair of Governors at Stars Trust and I have enjoyed being a Governor here for almost 8 years, including 7 as Chair.

Stanley Green Infant Academy and Starfish Nursery is a welcoming and friendly Stand-Alone Academy (SAT), set in extensive grounds in the beautiful coastal town of Poole. We are fortunate to have excellent facilities, which have been developed to provide a rich and stimulating learning and teaching environment for our children, staff and community. Our considerable school grounds set us apart from many infant schools and we take full advantage of our outside space. Our children can often be found engaging in outdoor learning and discovery and we have lots of keen gardeners in school.
