We are a group of 19 schools situated around Helston and the Lizard – the most southerly part of Cornwall. We are a co-operative Multi-Academy Trust. We believe in working together so that everyone benefits. Our work is underpinned by the co-operative values and these values inform everything we do.

It is important to us that schools maintain their uniqueness - we are not carbon copies of each other. There are core things that have to be aligned: our vision and values; HR as a single employer; financial practices; estates management; and core policies.
