#### Location

The school is located in a suburb to the West of Chesterfield. It is close to Chatsworth Road (A619) which connects the town with the Peak District. It is a 10-15 minute walk to the Town Centre which is well served by local buses and trains. The school takes children from a mixed catchment area: terraced housing, private semi-detached housing and social housing estates.

#### Accommodation

The school is located in well-maintained buildings dating back to the late 1800s. The building houses 12 classrooms, 2 halls, a staff room, a library, a servery kitchen and offices, along with a number of other areas used for children's learning. A new EYFS building has been erected this academic year. We are a larger than average sized primary school, with a PAN of 45 and NOR of 313. Numbers have been rising over recent years due to the school's growing reputation and consequently over 40% of the pupils on roll are from outside the normal school area. The school is particularly popular with parents of pupils with additional needs due to its inclusive ethos and many parents choose for their children to attend Brampton rather than their most local school.

Our Enhanced Resource Provision – the Rainbow Room, has its own access and outside space.

Outdoors there are numerous play areas including trim trails and grassed areas.

<u>Midday meals</u> are cooked and served on the premises by the Derbyshire County Catering Service.

## **Secondary Education**

Most pupils that attend Brampton Primary School from the normal area transfer to Parkside which is an 11-16 Comprehensive School or Brookfield Secondary School, which is an 11 to 18 Comprehensive School.

## **OFSTED Inspection**

The school was inspected in January 2019 and was judged to be a Good school.

## **Financial Budget**

The school's basic school budget for this financial year is £1,427,577, with an additional £149,186 of funding for GRIP/EHCP and £86,688 funding for ERS. 41% of our children are eligible for Free School Meals.

There are currently 25 (8%) with Education Health Care Plans, which is significantly above the national average (1.3%). The majority (14) of these pupils are placed in the enhanced resource facility for pupils with Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD). However, several pupils with EHC Plans attend mainstream provision and come from within the school's normal area. A significant number (92%) attend Brampton mainstream provision and come from the school's normal area due to parental choice as a result of our excellent reputation for inclusion.
