St John with St Michael (SJSM) CE Primary School is a warm and welcoming voluntary aided school set in the picturesque area of Shawforth in the Rossendale Valley.

We are a small school for pupils aged 4 - 11 years and have a Nursery unit where children can start from Rising 3. We currently have 107 children on roll and serve a village community.

Our most recent OFSTED inspection in March 2017 states that the school continues to be 'good'.

We also received a Diocesan SIAMS inspection in February 2019 and were awarded good in all areas with excellent support offered to pupils and their families, both within and beyond the school day, reflects the commitment of governors and staff to ensuring that the vision is lived out daily.

'Live, Love, Learn and Pray'


Reasons why we have chosen this vision:


