Thank you for taking the time to consider applying for the headship of Upperton J. and I. School. As chair of the governing body, I would like to take this opportunity to tell you a little bit about the context of our school.

We are situated six miles outside the centre of Huddersfield. It is a rural area that is beginning to be a lot more culturally diverse. There are 207 pupils currently on roll, in an area of declining birth rate.

There is a huge strength in the ethos of our school, developed by our Head Teacher of 18 years who is retiring. Staff stay because they feel valued, work collaboratively as a team, with the children at the heart of everything that they do.

We are looking to appoint an enthusiastic, inspiring, and dedicated leader who will take the school forward building on our strengths in order to meet our challenging targets.

When you visit our school, you will find children who are eager to learn and a dedicated and professional staff team who want the very best for the school community.

I hope I have given you a flavour of Upperthong School. We have every confidence that we will successfully recruit a Headteacher who will help us to continue to develop our vision to provide the best possible educational provision for the benefit of our pupils, their families and the community in which they live.
