

Inspectors recognised the hard work that had taken place to ensure Early Years, the curriculum and personal development are strong features of school provision. The school had begun to implement a new behaviour policy at the time of the inspection. Under the arrangements for inspection, the fact that this was not yet strongly embedded was a contributing factor for the school being judged as requires improvement.
