Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the post of HLTA at Millfield Primary School. The successful candidate will start in September and this is a permanent position. Your salary will be determined by skills and experience.

What does the role entail?

1. Under the direction of the SENCO, Progress Leader or class teacher, teach identified individuals and small groups whose learning needs supporting or accelerating
2. Teach whole classes, within the team you work on a daily basis, for example when the teacher is having PPA or leadership time, or to cover short term teacher absence.

Weeks and Hours of work

The weeks worked are 39, which is term-time plus 5 Professional days. Starting at approx 8:15am every day and with a half hour unpaid lunch break.

Rate of Pay

The salary will be determined by skills and experience, with the HLTA range starting at £21,744.75 per annum. The hourly rate is based on 33.75hrs and paid weeks of 44.45. Pay is spread over 52 weeks.

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Working within a team

All our TAs are part of a team, led by our SENCo, the team leader (Progress Leader) and class teacher. We take great pride in the fact that all our staff work very closely together, supporting and challenging each other so that we provide the best we can for our children.

A little bit about the school

Millfield Primary School is an above average sized primary school expanding over the next 2 years to approximately 420 children. It serves part of the growing town of Littleport which is close to the city of Ely. Almost all pupils are of white British heritage with a few pupils with English as a second language. Pupils come from a wide range of backgrounds and overall, whilst their social and economic circumstances are broadly average, two thirds sit within 'low average'. The school has broadly average FSM and SEN but the children tend to start school with poor language and communication skills.
