

HISTORY DEPARTMENT

We are seeking an inspirational, enthusiastic and innovative History teacher to join our diverse team in this high achieving 11-16 comprehensive school. The History department is very successful. We are looking for someone to contribute to this success; someone who will actively participate within the department and further enrich our pupils' experiences within History.

The History department at The Romsey School consists of four specialist teachers. History is taught in four classrooms in East block. In 2022 our GCSE results were successful where 70% attained a 4+ grade, 64% a 5+ and 27% a 7+ with a significant number of grade 9s.

The History department utilises SMART boards and digital projectors to improve teaching and learning all of the classroom as well as networked computers. Resources are shared through a central shared area on the school computer system. Staff within the History department use a range of software with all ages and abilities, and this forms one of the many different techniques utilised to allow rapid and sustained progress for all pupils. We also utilise Google Classroom as our main online learning tool and are developing it to deliver all homework and follow up information.

History teachers have a balanced timetable, teaching the full range of ages and abilities. Pupils are taught in mixed ability sets. These sets are the same for all humanities lessons. The History Department is part of The Humanities Faculty which also includes Geography, RE, PSHE and Sociology.

The department meets on a regular basis and all teachers contribute. The focus for department meetings is on the improvement of teaching and learning and they often take the form of a workshop.

Faculty staff also play a wider role in the school and community and have been instrumental in extracurricular activities.
