Curriculum

The current Ethics and PSHE curricula are varied and engaging, offering students opportunities to develop their understanding of religions, philosophy and ethics and also their understanding of the world around them and their place within it. The challenge embedded within the schemes of work is developmental, preparing the students for high order thinking and increasingly demanding learning experiences as their Ethics and PSHE studies progress. Schemes of work in place follow 'Key Competencies'. Our Key Competencies are an integral part of the curriculum and are used to assess, monitor and track pupil progress as well as inform curriculum planning and development.

At Key Stage 3 students follow a varied programme of study including the study of Abrahamic Religions as well as engaging in ethical and philosophical debate.

At Key Stage 4, students follow the AQA Sociology specification.

The PSHE curriculum is delivered across the school encompasses a wide range of topics including personal safety, relationship and sex education, social skills and tolerance.
