A new opportunity has been created for an Inclusion and Wellbeing Mentor to join Swallowdale Primary School from 27th August 2024. The post holder will be responsible for further shaping our provision for pastoral and wellbeing support within the school. Working closely with the Class Teachers, Behaviour Lead and SENDCo the successful candidate will deliver a specialist mentoring service to bridge learning and pastoral support for pupils and those engaged with them, in order to remove barriers to learning and raise standards. This is an exciting opportunity for someone to work in collaboration with the Head Teacher to develop the role, ensuring our children with SEMH needs are provided with mentoring/tutoring and support in order for them to access the curriculum to minimise barriers to learning and maximise pupil participation.
