- National SENDCo qualification or other appropriate experience/qualifications.
- Level 3 Safeguarding qualification (or willingness to undertake training)

2. Experience

- Proven track record as a successful teaching practitioner within the Primary age range
- Experience of leading staff training and INSET
- Experience of working effectively with parents to ensure the best possible outcomes for children.
- Experience of successful inter-agency work.
- Experience of successful leadership and management within a school
- Proven experience of improving teaching and achievement for pupils including Pupil Premium, SEND, EAL, Looked After and vulnerable pupils.
- Experience of safeguarding work

3. Knowledge and understanding

- Knowledge of relevant legislation in particular of the SEN Code of Practice, equal opportunities and disability discrimination legislation
- Knowledge of the range and type of interventions available and be able to apply these appropriately in the context of the School's resources and the individual child.
