- Liaise with parents of underperforming children.
- Support students in English lessons.
- Deliver Literacy Intervention Programmes to small group interventions.
- Carry out all such other duties as your Line Manager may reasonably direct.
- Lead homework interventions and support Pupil Premium children in Homework Club.
- Be a Form tutor, supporting the form with attendance, behaviour, and attainment.
