Welcome to Exhall Grange Learning Pod, a specialist provision for young people, from aged 14 to 18 years old, with complex social communication difficulties and mental health needs. There are a maximum of eight young people at any one time in The Learning Pod. It is a safe, calm and relaxed environment. All of our young people are listened to, treated with respect, and are supported by keyworkers to reach their fullest potential. We work with young people, their families and other professionals to ensure the best possible outcome is achieved for our young people.



Our history

The learning Pod first opened its doors in Coleshill, in 2016. In December purpose built facility which consists of a large learning space, two smaller learning spaces, a lounge, and kitchen and dining area. We also have a room called "Space" which is designed to be low sensory stimulation for our young people to readjust, rebalance and relax when needed.
