PERMANENT FULL TIME KEY STAGE 2 TEACHER

Thank you for your interest in this post which is offered from September 2022. I enclose a job profile and person specification, along with an application form. Please complete the application and return it to us by **9am on Thursday 19th May**. Please make clear on your application your experience as a subject leader and leading whole school developments, as well as any curriculum interests/strengths. We anticipate interviewing short-listed candidates on **Monday 23rd May** with the interview panel comprising myself, Abigail Jardine (Headteacher from April) and at least one member of the Local Governing Body. As part of the interview, short-listed candidates will be asked to teach a lesson to current Year 4 and Year 5 pupils.

The school is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children in its care and expects all staff to share this commitment. The school recognises that an important element in keeping children safe from harm is to ensure that unsuitable people do not have access to the school. Applicants will be required to undertake pre-employment checks which will include excellent references (to include an assessment of the candidate's suitability to work in a school), health, right to work in the UK and Disclosure and Barring Service. The successful candidate will be expected to follow and contribute to the school's policy for Child Protection (available from the school and on the school website). All disabled applicants who meet the essential criteria in the person specification will be interviewed. All applicants will be considered on the basis of suitability regardless of sex, race, gender, religion or belief, marital status or disability.

The successful candidate should have recent relevant experience of teaching and assessment in Key Stage 2, dealing with pupils with challenging behaviour and Special Educational Needs and leading whole school developments and/or a key subject area. The teaching commitment is 5 days (Monday to Friday) with PPA and ECT time for any early career teachers, teaching 17 Year 5 and 6 pupils along with leading curriculum areas which can be discussed to align with your passion and strengths. This is a full time teaching commitment. This is an exciting opportunity to be part of a new teaching team whilst working alongside those who are established in the school.

The school is an academy as part of the 'Good Shepherd Multi Academy Trust'. The successful candidate's employment would be with the Good Shepherd Multi Academy Trust although the terms and conditions would be comparable to Cumbria County Council.
