What is a Leadership Scholar?

Castle Phoenix Trust offers Scholarships in Leadership to those who have proven they are ready to take on a new level of leadership challenge, and need to acquire the skills ready to do so. A scholarship is awarded alongside a specific leadership responsibility, enhancing your ability to carry out that role, and can therefore only be awarded by the headteacher of each school. The scholarship itself lasts for two years, and can start at any point in the academic year.

The scholarship programme will support you in developing the skills, knowledge, understanding and confidence you need to be a highly effective leader able to contribute to the strategic development of your school, through a pastoral, academic, admin or other team.


Scholarship overview

You will have two opportunities to report directly to a senior leadership team, gaining experience of presenting your intentions and their impact on wholeschool development.
