SAST is a family of 17 schools across Dorset and South Somerset, and together we are working to deliver excellent education to more than 5,000 children in our area. There is real strength in coming together with a collective responsibility for children's education between 0-19 years.

We have the scale, capacity, expertise and performance to grow and develop with other schools. The Trust has large town primary schools with over 300 children, smaller village primary schools and also nursery provision. We have three secondary schools, two popular Sixth Forms, state boarding, and an alternative provision. There is a mix of formerly maintained, and Church of England schools in the Dioceses of Salisbury and Bath and Wells, which retain their Christian ethos.



# **OUR SCHOOLS:**



SAST currently has 17 schools across North and West Dorset and South Somerset. We have 2 nurseries, 13 primary schools, 3 secondary schools (two of which have Sixth Forms) and an alternative provision. Many of our schools are clustered around Sherborne and Shaftesbury, and there is no more than 40 minutes travel time between any of our schools.

# SECONDARY SCHOOLS & SIXTH FORMS

#### The Gryphon School, Sherborne

The Gryphon School is a popular secondary school and Sixth Form which attracts nearly 1,600 students from across North and West Dorset, and South Somerset. It is a Church of England school, whilst being highly inclusive and embracing of all faiths. The school focuses on high achievement both personally and academically, and strives to be outstanding in all respects.



#### King Arthur's School, Wincanton

King Arthur's is an 11-16 school in the historic town of Wincanton. The school has been on a transformational journey over the last few years, and is now seeing it's popularity increase rapidly. Students thrive and succeed in KA's positive, caring and respectful environment.

# Information about Sherborne, Wincanton, Shaftesbury and surrounding areas

#### **Sherborne**

Sherborne is certainly one of the most beautiful towns in England, with its many medieval buildings, a stunning abbey dating from Saxon times, world-famous schools and two picturesque castles.

It is ideally located on the Dorset and Somerset border, and has excellent transport links - a direct rail line to London, and Bath, Salisbury, Exeter and the Jurassic Coast are all within easy reach.

Sherborne is renowned as a centre of educational excellence. We have strong links with the private schools in the town, working in partnership to share expertise and opportunities.





#### Wincanton

Wincanton is a small market town, nestled on the border of South Somerset, Dorset and Wiltshire. Smaller than nearby fashionable towns of Bruton and Frome, it is seen as an up and coming spot for those looking to move to the countryside. Direct rail lines to London are only a 15 minute drive away, and it is only a short drive from Sherborne and Yeovil.

#### **Shaftesbury**

The town of Shaftesbury sits on a hill high above Dorset's Blackmore Vale, with beautiful views. It is steeped in history and charm. the high street is packed with independent shops, cafes and restaurants, and it is the site of the famous Gold Hill or 'Hovis Hill' as many know it.

Located close to Gillingham and Tisbury with direct train lines to London, the countryside east of the town is part of Cranborne Chase and the West Wiltshire Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.



## Support with relocating

Every year we have new employees joining SAST, many staff choose to live in Sherborne, Shaftesbury or the surrounding villages. House prices are a little lower in Yeovil, or other Dorset towns like Dorchester and Gillingham. Some staff comfortably travel from Somerset or Devon, and we are easily accessible from Bath, Taunton and Bournemouth which are slightly further afield.

We are very happy to provide informal guidance about available accommodation; some new staff like to share, and staff often share transport.
