Thank you for showing an interest in this exciting new position, suitable for an experienced SENCO to take the next step in their career. We would like to appoint someone with the skills and drive to provide leadership of other SENCOs across the growing number of schools in the Windsor Learning Partnership. In the first instance the position will be 0.6 as a SENCO at The Windsor Boys' School and 0.4 providing leadership and coordination of the other SENCOs across the Trust. However, as the trust expands and takes on more schools this may change into an increasingly larger role as a leading SENCO across Windsor. This post is a tremendous career opportunity for the right candidate.

The Windsor Learning Partnership is a recently formed Multi Academy Trust that provides a coordinated education experience across a number of schools in Windsor and provides a network across other schools in the area. Windsor has a three tier system, first schools, middle schools and upper schools which provides an opportunity to focus specifically on the needs of children in those three phases, but which does require a higher level of coordination and collaboration for the sake of the children. The Lead SENCO is a new post and is viewed by us as being essential to taking SEND in the WLP to a very high level.

The Windsor Boys' School is a thriving upper school with a distinctly inclusive character and an above average number of students with SEND. The Windsor Girls School is an outstanding school with a number of students with complex needs. Dedworth Middle School is developing an ASD resource base for the site, and Dedworth Green First School has national recognition for its work on nurture. The Windsor Learning Partnership is dedicated to serving the needs of all children in the Windsor area, and securing a very robust SEND structure and system in the Trust is a key priority.
