We are looking to appoint an enthusiastic and expert Lead Teacher of Psychology to lead the Psychology provision at Notre Dame High School. You will be an excellent classroom practitioner with a genuine passion for Psychology, able to lead by example and inspire our pupils to foster a 'psychological imagination'. As Subject Lead, you will be expected to lead and review the development of the Psychology curriculum and monitor student progress and performance, as well as make a positive contribution to the wider Social Sciences department. This is an exciting opportunity for a dedicated teacher to develop their career within a school that prides itself with investing in teacher CPD.

With over 170 psychology students across A-Level, this position allows the candidate to work extensively within our highly successful Sixth Form. At Notre Dame, our Sixth Form is large and vibrant, with almost a 450-student population. The Sixth Form adopts a comprehensive ethos and we have students attending from all around the city and surrounding areas.

This summer our Sixth Form achieved their best ever results, with A* to C grades up at 75%. Additionally, 83% of students progressed to university for a 2025 start, with 43% securing places at Russell Group universities, which is significantly above the national average.

The Psychology results remain consistency strong, alongside other subjects in Social Sciences. The department prides itself in offering plentiful student enrichment activities to support student experience and engagement.

The department delivers an array of subjects, including EDUQAS A-Level Psychology, AQA A-Level Sociology, Level 3 AAQ BTEC Health and Social Care, Level 3 WJEC EPQ, Level 1-2 NCFE Health and Social Care and Level 1-2 NCFE Child Care and Development. The ability to teach another subject would be an advantage. We are based mainly in Oakbrook House which is the main hub for Sixth Form teaching.

Notre Dame is a Catholic school with a strong ethos at its heart. All staff are expected to uphold and contribute to the ethos of the school, which is what makes it a special place to work.
