ACTIVITIES

We use the Zones of Regulation, Lego Therapy, Play Therapy, Social Stories and Sensory Circuits to support pupils to develop the ability to identify and articulate their feelings and to understand how these feelings impact on themselves and others as well as develop vital self-regulation skills.

Children will be immersed in practical, real life activities to develop life skills, build self-confidence and learn how to interact with adults, peers and animals responsibly and safely. Using our Forest School activities, we focus on the whole child and supporting the development of confidence and self-esteem. We also use therapeutic animal experiences, such as holding and stroking our rabbits and being involved in animal care.
