## Literacy and Numeracy Tutor 33.3 hours per week, 37 weeks per year. Unqualified Teacher/Main Pay Scale Depending on Qualifications Fixed Term until Summer 2022

Disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic have resulted in significant missed education by students. Disadvantaged and vulnerable students have been particularly impacted. Teddington School will be using the 2021/22 Government grant to fund the role of a **Literacy and Numeracy Tutor**, who will work with small groups of students in all year groups whose progress continues to be impacted negatively by the school lockdowns during the pandemic.

This role would suit either a qualified teacher or someone with a competent background in literacy and numeracy looking to experience work in the education sector. Full training and support will be given, and the successful candidate will be working with small groups of students to underpin the curriculum being delivered in classrooms.

This role is term time only, for 33.3 hours per week (Mon 8:20am-4pm, Tues-Thurs 8:30am-4pm, Fri 8:30am-3pm including a 40-minute unpaid lunch break each day). This post is currently funded until the end of the 2021/22 academic year.
