Role Purpose

To work as a proactive member of a dedicated team, ensuring the safety, welfare, and social development of pupils during the midday break. You will create a safe, stimulating, and inclusive environment, supporting children during their meals and encouraging positive play.

Key Responsibilities

- **Pupil Support & Supervision:**
 - Supervise children in the dining hall, playground, and classrooms during inclement weather.
 - Ensure the safety and well-being of all pupils, providing support to help them access all lunchtime activities.
 - Promote the inclusion and acceptance of all pupils, regardless of their needs or background.
 - **Dining & Hygiene:**
 - Maintain high standards of cleanliness and hygiene, following daily cleaning rotas.
 - Clear and clean tables and the school hall promptly at the end of the lunch period.
 - Foster a "pleasant social sharing" atmosphere during mealtimes, encouraging good table manners and healthy eating.
 - **Play & Engagement:**
 - Encourage children to interact positively with one another.
 - Lead and engage children in a range of playground games and activities suited to various needs.
 - Assist in the preparation and clearing away of play equipment.
 - **Safeguarding & School Culture:**
 - Adhere to all school policies, particularly those regarding safeguarding, child protection, and health and safety.
 - Act as a positive role model for pupils at all times.
