Job Title: Supervisory Assistant

## Role:

To actively supervise the pupils in the dining room, playground and throughout the school premises during the lunchtime period.

## **Main Duties**

- 1. Supporting pupils while they eat their lunch, cutting up food for pupils and making sure tables are clean and that water is available
- 2. Ensure standards for healthy eating and table manners are maintained
- 3. Report accidents to the Lunchtime Leader and complete accident form if necessary
- 4. Deliver minor first aid and reassurance to children where required
- 5. Ensure that school discipline policies are implemented
- 6. Support the work of other Supervisory Assistants
- 7. Support induction and training of new staff as required
- 8. Respond to duty delegation as required
- 9. Lead the children in the establishment of suitable playground games/activities
- 10. Record inappropriate pupil behaviour and convey serious incidents to class teacher or senior leadership team (SLT)
- 11. Maintain checks throughout the lunch break to ensure pupils are safe
- 12. Follow advice given by SLT on action to be taken in cases of inclement weather
- 13. To demonstrate a commitment to the safeguarding of pupils and to complying with the school's child protection procedures
- 14. To ensure promotion and support of Equal Opportunities and Health & Safety
- 15. To undertake any other duties that are commensurate with the post
