## **MAIN PURPOSE:**

To be responsible for challenging and supporting children to ensure high standards of teaching and learning by actively upholding the policies and ethos of this school: to contribute to the wider school community including leading an area of the curriculum and working towards the school's continuing development.

## Accountabilities: -

- Carry out the duties of a class teacher as stipulated in the teachers' pay and conditions document and to continue to demonstrate the Teachers Standards,
- Plan and prepare (co-operatively and independently) appropriate work and resources to achieve the complete and broad curriculum,
- Assess and monitor the progress of each child and set appropriate learning objectives and targets,
- Provide a stimulating, purposeful and well organised learning environment,
- Liaise with and report to parents, carers and outside agencies to ensure effective communication.
- Support the practices of the wider school community including participating in student training,
- Participate in and contribute to year group and curriculum teams,
- Monitor teaching and learning of identified curricular area, ensuring policies and schemes of work are reviewed and updated regularly and staff are informed of new developments,
- Ensure the health and safety of children throughout the day,

- Demonstrate a commitment to evaluate, reflect on and improve own practice and subject specialism, taking responsibility for identifying and meeting own CPD needs,
- Contribute to the priorities identified in the School Development Plan and work towards its achievement.

## **Competencies**

- Managing pupils including challenge and support,
- · Team working including commitment and flexibility,
- Information seeking including skills of observation and reflection,
- Creating trust including skills of communication, respect and empathy,
- Developing the potential of children.
