Thank you for your interest in the vacancy for **Teacher of Mathematics** at St Edmund Arrowsmith **Catholic** High School.

Our aim has always been to inspire every pupil to want to make the world a better place. This aim sits above all others in defining an education for our pupils.

We are seeking a practitioner who is passionate about achievement and outcomes for young people both academically and personally and if you would like to join our school community as a colleague who is committed to these values, then I look forward to receiving your application form.

Our team of dedicated Mathematicians encourage pupils to develop a love for the subject, to help them to recognise all the beneficial applications of Maths in our world. The framework in place also supports the development of a range of cross-curricular skills, which will help pupils across all their subjects and in their everyday lives.

The Department is extremely well-resourced with 10 classrooms which are all equipped with the latest technology. Students will follow a bespoke 5-year curriculum that stretches and challenges all of our pupils and ensures a continuity in their learning from KS2. Pupils have (7) x 1-hour lessons of Mathematics over a fortnight; (selected pupils have an additional (2) x 1-hour lessons a fortnight in KS3 as part of our "Covid-recovery" intervention). At the start of Y10, pupils are selected to participate in an additional (5) x 1-hour lessons of Mathematics over a fortnight.

In 2021, 78% of our pupils achieved grades 9 – 4; over 30% of the grades achieved by our pupils were at grades 7 - 9. We are delighted that 22 of our pupils achieved a grade 9.
