- Support the Head of Mathematics in the leadership, management and development of the Mathematics department
- Work closely with the Head of Department to create a collaborative team ethos within the Mathematics department
- Meet with the Head of Mathematics on a regular basis to discuss and co-ordinate the work of the department
- Be responsible and accountable to the Head of Department for the leadership and management of Mathematics at Key Stage 3, the development and implementation of curriculum maps, schemes of learning, monitoring and evaluating the quality of teaching and learning and setting targets for improvement
- Ensure that members of the department are following the prescribed schemes of work at Key Stage 3
- Monitor the quality of Teaching and Learning folders at Key Stage 3
- Ensure that teachers are following the college homework and feedback policy at Key Stage 3
- Performance manage identified teachers within the department
- Contribute to developing effective links with the local community including feeder primary schools, businesses etc. in order to broaden the Mathematics curriculum
- Promote extra-curricular activities and visits linked to the study of Mathematics
- Lead items at department meetings

- Promote good behaviour, attendance and punctuality through implementing college policies
- Work closely with the Head of Department to ensure that Mathematics meets the requirements of the GCSE exam boards
