Core Purpose:

In addition to carrying out the professional duties of a teacher in accordance with the Teacher Standards, the post holder shall, in consultation with the Faculty Lead and the Headteacher:

Key Accountabilities

- Teach across the age and ability range, in line with the programmes of study, in such a way as to challenge and inspire pupils of all abilities enabling them to make 'good' progress. Exercising a qualified teacher's professional skills and judgement.
- Plan, prepare and teach lessons to pupils assigned to his/her according to the pupils' educational needs with reference to prior attainment, SEND and English as an additional language as required.
- Assess, record and report on the development, progress and attainment of pupils assigned to him/ her in line with School policies.
- Contribute to the planning and implementation of the curriculum under the guidance of the Faculty Leader.
- Set high expectations for pupil behaviour establishing and maintaining a good standard of discipline through well focused teaching and through positive and productive relationships.
- Be familiar with, support and reinforce the aims, ethos, policies and procedures of the School
- Contribute to the School's enrichment programme.
- Attend all calendared meetings as required.

Other responsibilities:

- Act at all times as an ambassador for the School in a manner which upholds its values and ethos and to model behaviour consistent with the School's standards and aspirations.
- Take an active role in the School's pastoral care of pupils and fulfil a pastoral and mentoring role.
- Foster good relationships with parents and the wider community.
- Have an agreed flexible working pattern to ensure that all relevant functions, including extracurricular activities, are fulfilled.
- Demonstrate a commitment to personal professional development and the development of other staff.
- Be subject to performance objectives agreed annually and will be responsible for providing evidence of progress for key accountabilities.
- Carry out such other duties as may reasonably be assigned by the Headteacher.
