# Job Description

## Midday Assistant

*The School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment*

### **Key responsibilities: - (Midday Assistant)**

Ensure that the pupil/pupils are kept safe during the lunchtime.

Establish effective relationships with the pupil/pupils, acting as a role model at all times.

Ensure the orderly entry of the pupil/pupils into the dining hall.

Ensure good behaviour in the dinner hall and on the yard.

Direct pupil/pupils to a seat,

Supervise the pupil/pupils in the dining hall including general advice on table manners and procedures e.g. correct use of knife and fork

Encourage the pupil/pupils to eat.

Assist the pupil/pupils with cutting up food, pouring liquids etc. where necessary.

Ensure that the pupil/pupils clear up in a satisfactory manner.

Supervise the pupil/pupils in playground areas and on school premises before lunch and during lunch.

Supervise the pupil/pupils in class during wet play ensuring that the class is kept safe, calm and orderly.

Ensure that the pupil/pupils have been to the toilet and washed their hands ready for afternoon school.

Administer First Aid in school, comforting and cleaning the pupil/pupils as necessary

Promote the school's positive Behaviour Policy and actively model appropriate language and manners.

Promote good pupil behaviour, dealing promptly with conflict and incidents and encouraging pupils to take responsibility for their own behaviour in line with established school policy.

Encourage the pupil/pupils to interact with others positively and engage in activities in the playground.

Report any serious incidents to the Headteacher and class teacher.

Be aware of, and support, difference and ensure all pupils have equal access to opportunities to play, learn and develop.

Be willing to undertake training as necessary.

### **Duties and Responsibilities**

This job description sets out the duties of the post at the time it was drawn up. The post holder may be required from time to time to undertake other duties within the school as may be reasonably expected, without changing the general character of the duties or the level of responsibility entailed. This is a common occurrence and would not justify a reconsideration of the grading of the post.

## Job Description – Cleaner

*The School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment*

### **Key responsibilities:**

To provide a good standard of cleaning to all buildings working within health and safety guidelines and meeting current legislation.
To complete, on a daily basis, all duties including Job Card using specific floor plans.
To wear, at all times, appropriate uniforms and other PPE as supplied in accordance with health and safety legislation.
Undertaken any training required to provide a safe service.
To take care of corporate assets, bringing any defects to the attention of the line manager.
Responsibility for completion of personal timesheet ensuring it arrives timely into the office on a monthly basis
Ensure good housekeeping, keeping cleaning stores clean and tidy ensuring implements stored correctly.
To be vigilant and report any potential risks within your work area to your line manager preventing unnecessary incidents.
Cleaning tasks may include any of the following for which training will be given: vacuuming, mopping, damp wiping, toilet/urinal cleaning, wall washing, carpet cleaning, stripping and polishing floors.
Follow audit requirements, Sign attendance book correctly increase productivity by arriving into the work area on time and leaving after fulfilling the contractual hours.
Work as part of a team appreciating and supporting the role of other people in the team.
Undertake personal development through training and other learning activities as required.
Attend and participate in meetings as required.
Be aware of and comply with policies and procedures relating to child protection, health and safety and security, confidentiality and data protection, reporting all concerns to an appropriate person.
Be aware of and support difference to help ensure everyone has equal access to the facilities and feels valued, respecting their social, cultural, linguistic, religious and ethnic background.
Undertake personal development through training and other learning activities as required

Note: Undertake any other duties and responsibilities as may be assigned from time to time, which are commensurate with the grade of the job.
