Job Title: Midday Supervisor

Grade: Grade 1 (points 1 - 2)

Reports To: Senior Midday Supervisor/Principal

Main purposes of the job

- To ensure the health and safety of children at lunchtimes under the direction of the appropriate person as identified by the school.
- To be responsible for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young people within the school.

Responsibilities and Roles

- 1. To supervise the children at all times during lunchtime on the school premises.
- 2. Ensure that the children are behaving appropriately in line with the schools' behaviour policy at all times including the dining room, playground and during wet lunch times.
- 3. To engage with the children and ensure that they are active in purposeful and cooperative behaviour throughout the lunchtime period.
- 4. In the event of any spillage inform the appropriate person and take necessary action immediately to avoid possible accidents.
- 5. To follow the schools' policy and procedures on child protection.
- 6. To take reasonable precautions whilst in charge of the children to see that they do nothing that is likely to injure themselves or others.
- 7. In the event of any injuries or sickness, deal immediately with the situation referring to the appropriate person making sure they are dealt with according to the school's policy and procedure.
- 8. To challenge and report any stranger on site.
- 9. Inform the appropriate member of staff in regard to behaviour at lunchtimes this includes positive and negative behaviours.
- 10. Keep the appropriate person informed of any information that may relate to a child's health and safety.
- 11. Ensure that you are a strong, positive role model for the children and other staff.
- 12. To undertake broadly similar duties commensurate with the level of the post.
- 13. To adhere to all the school's policies and Trust's Ethos Policy.
- 14. Actively participate in any appropriate training when required.
